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### Summary

- Fiscal-year-equated students 2000-01 are projected to increase 1.01% (2,298) over 1999-00 (230,311 vs. 228,013) - Table 1
- Total headcount for Fall 2000 increased 1.40% over Fall 1999 (272,210 vs. 268,441) - Table 2
- Instructional activity, as measured by Fall 2000 full-time-equated students (FTES), increased 1.81% (3,801) over Fall term 1999 ( 214,072 vs. 210,271) - Table 2
- Fall 2000 first-time freshmen enrollment increased 3.92% over Fall 1999 and graduate student headcount increased .55% over Fall term 1999 - Tables 4 and 6, respectively
